

Hygiene and Safety Measures – Diagnostics-4-Future Conference 2021

- In accordance with the current Corona regulation of Baden-Württemberg: Participation in the event is only possible with a valid COVID certificate (recovered, vaccinated, PCR-tested). The proof will be checked before admission.
- We expect most of our participants to enjoy immunisation protection against COVID-19. If admission under the current regulation is possible for participants who are not vaccinated or recovered, we offer PCR tests for SARS-CoV-2 on site before the conference. The tests will be conducted on the first conference day, 25 October 2021, at 8:00 am. Previous registration for the test is required. The tests will be monitored by Dr. med. Friedemann Taut ([Taut Science and Service GmbH](#)) and analysed by [myPOLLS Biotec](#) on behalf of the organizer.
- We recommend all participants to take a COVID-19 self-test the evening before the event, even if they are recovered or vaccinated.
- If you suffer from typical COVID-19 symptoms or have been in contact with a COVID-19 patient within 14 days prior to the event, please refrain from attending the event.

- All participants are informed about hygiene and safety measures prior to the event.
- With their registration, participants explicitly accept the organizers' hygiene and safety measures and the processing of personal data by the organizers. If necessary, these data will be transferred to the health authorities for contact tracing.

- Face masks are mandatory in the entire building (except catering areas while eating/drinking).
- Please bring your own appropriate face mask (surgical mask or FFP2 mask).
- A minimum distance of 1.50 m is recommended.
- The area in front of the main entrance is separated by barriers. Starting at the entrance door, routes (entrance/exit) are designated by arrows on the floor and separated by belt barriers.
- At the entrance, disinfectant dispensers for regular hand hygiene are provided.
- Guest elevators may only be used by two people simultaneously.
- Rooms are ventilated regularly.
- All relevant surfaces or contact areas are cleaned regularly.
- Hygiene and safety measures are displayed on the premises (notices, signs etc.).

- General hygiene recommendations of the Robert Koch Institute should be respected (www.rki.de).
